

Sacramento Betsuin Sports Program Coaches Agreement

This Coaches Agreement is a way to ensure that all coaches are aware of the scope and purpose of the NCCL (Northern California Church League) Basketball Program. The NCCL is the governing body for our basketball program.

According to the Betsuin's Sports Program By-Laws, the objective is:

“Sacramento’s Betsuin Sports Program is to develop a program for our Dharma School Children that will provide an organized activity in which they can develop friendships and positive social skills through playing team sports; essential to this goal is to nurture an understanding of sportsmanship and fair play.”

With this “objective” in mind, it is expected that a Betsuin coach teaches our youth the principles of sportsmanship, fair play, skill development, and mutual respect among players, coaches, officials, and spectators.

Given this expectation, you, as a Betsuin Coach, are expected to:

- Know and teach the rules. (See Betsuin and NCCL By-Laws attached herein.)
- Motivate and make it fun for each player.
- Emphasize team concepts and that there is no “I” in team.
- Respect the game officials and refrain from being disrespectful to others.
- Ensure players conduct themselves with sportsmanship and maturity.
- Lead by example and teach each player to be humble and gracious in victory and proud and courteous in defeat.
- Realize, accept and practice the principal that a team’s reputation is built not only on its wins and losses, but on sportsmanship, courtesy, and manner.
- Coach in a positive manner and do not use derogatory comments or abusive language.
- Help ensure your players behave in church by reminding them.
- Always keep in mind that this is “church” league, NOT a competitive league.
- Always keep in mind that skill development and team ideals are the goal.
- Keep in mind that you represent the Betsuin.
- Coaching assignments are for one year only.

Remember, there is no trophy, no champion, and no one gets paid to do this, so take pride in teaching and guiding our youth to become upstanding adults.
